

Monday Night Mixed Curling Rules for 2023 – 2024

- **Round Robin Games -**

The **Team Format** has 10 teams while the **Club Curling** group has 4 teams to start the year.

The two groups will alternate times between 6 pm and 8:10 pm week to week. No end can start after 7:50 pm. on the 6 pm draw. The rules of the Canadian Curling Association apply and we will be using the free guard zone five rock rule.

- **First Game** on October 30 is 6 ends. All games thereafter are 8 ends.

- **Scores –**

It is the responsibility of the vice skips to record the scores and ends won.

- **Breaking Ties -**

Ties will not be broken this year and each team will get 1 point.

- **Point System –**

- Win 2 points
- Tie 1 point
- Loss 0 point

- **If curling is cancelled** due to inclement weather, no scores will be posted for that evening and we will continue to follow the scheduled dates. For example, if curling is canceled for December 5th, we will play December 12th games as shown on the posted schedule.

- **Snacks –** to be determined

- **Spares -**

- If you are unable to attend your scheduled game, you or your skip should arrange for a spare who may play any position. A spare list is shown below the list of teams on the bulletin board. A non-member may spare for a daily fee of **\$20.00**. Day members and 1 league evening members may spare a maximum of 3 times without a fee. Thereafter, the fee is **\$20.00** per game. Curlers with a full membership do not pay to spare. Skips should collect these fees and give to the bartender to give to the Club Administrator.
- A minimum of three players is required and at least one player must be a member of the original team and at least one male and female curler must be present. Otherwise, the game can still be played but is forfeited by that team and the score will be recorded as 4-0.
